telepark launches teamslide: first cross-platform web presentation solution

Munich, April 27, 2006 - telepark, a leading developer of Online Software for personal productivity, today announced the launch of **teamslide**, the first cross-platform web presentation solution. teamslide is a very simple and inexpensive way to show PowerPoint slides to one or more viewers using nothing but a web browser, no plug-in's or player software required. teamslide runs on AJAX technology and enables live, remote-controlled web presentations across all platforms' leading web browsers: Firefox, Safari and Internet Explorer on Windows, Mac, and Linux. AJAX is short for Asynchronous JavaScript And XML. It is a relatively new web programming methodology designed to advance the cause of the lighter yet more powerful and platform agnostic applications like teamslide.

“teamslide will revolutionize the way we think of PowerPoint presentations – where once you had to download a big file now you click a link and the presentation pops right up. And as the first truly cross-platform solution it marks a huge leap forward for live web presentations,” said Patrick Thomas, CEO of telepark. “This makes teamslide a very compelling offer for any business or professional looking for an easy-to-use and reliable web presentation system.”

Keeping confidential slides private

telepark offers teamslide as Online Software for installation on the buyer's personal webserver or hosted webspace. The buyer needs a webspace with support for PHP 4.3.10 or PHP 5.x to run teamslide which is common functionality for almost all hosting providers. “The fact that confidential slide content stays on the buyers own server instead of being shared with a third party is very appealing to many businesses,” explains Patrick Thomas. „Contrary to common wisdom, installing Online Software such as teamslide on a webserver is easier and faster than the installation of conventional desktop software. It's upload and run.“

1-click conversion of PowerPoint presentations

telepark offers a free PowerPoint add-in for 1-click conversion of PowerPoint presentations to teamslide slidesets. Based on JPG and XML file standards, these slidesets use data



compression to reduce the upload package size to less than half the original PowerPoint file size, saving time and server space.

Flexible live web presentations

teamslide is offered for use with up to 5 participants and one presenter although the number of participants is solely dependent on the customers webserver and can be much higher. It is perfect for collaboration tasks such as presentation-supported sales consulting over the phone, group medical diagnostics, eTraining, sales and marketing reporting, closed-group presentations such as phone auctions, agency pitches and campaign planning, project management updates, and financial analyst presentations.

License packages

teamslide is designed to meet the remote presentation needs of businesses, professional groups as well as project teams and comes in three license packages: a single-user package for freelancers and a 5- and 10-user package for small to medium-sized businesses. All license packages are available for online purchase and delivered immediately by instant download. teamslide pricing starts at \$99 for a single presenter and any number of participants.
